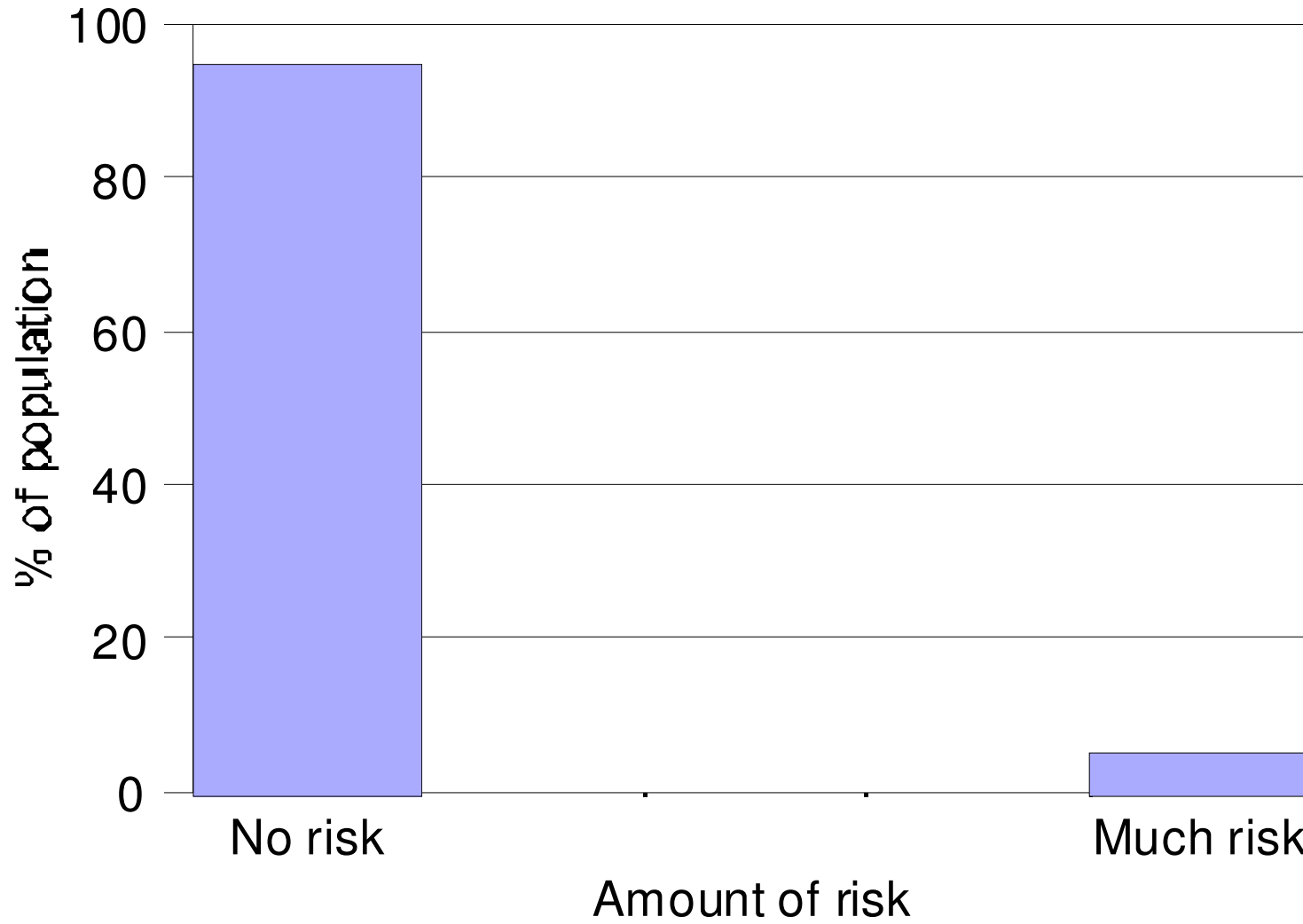

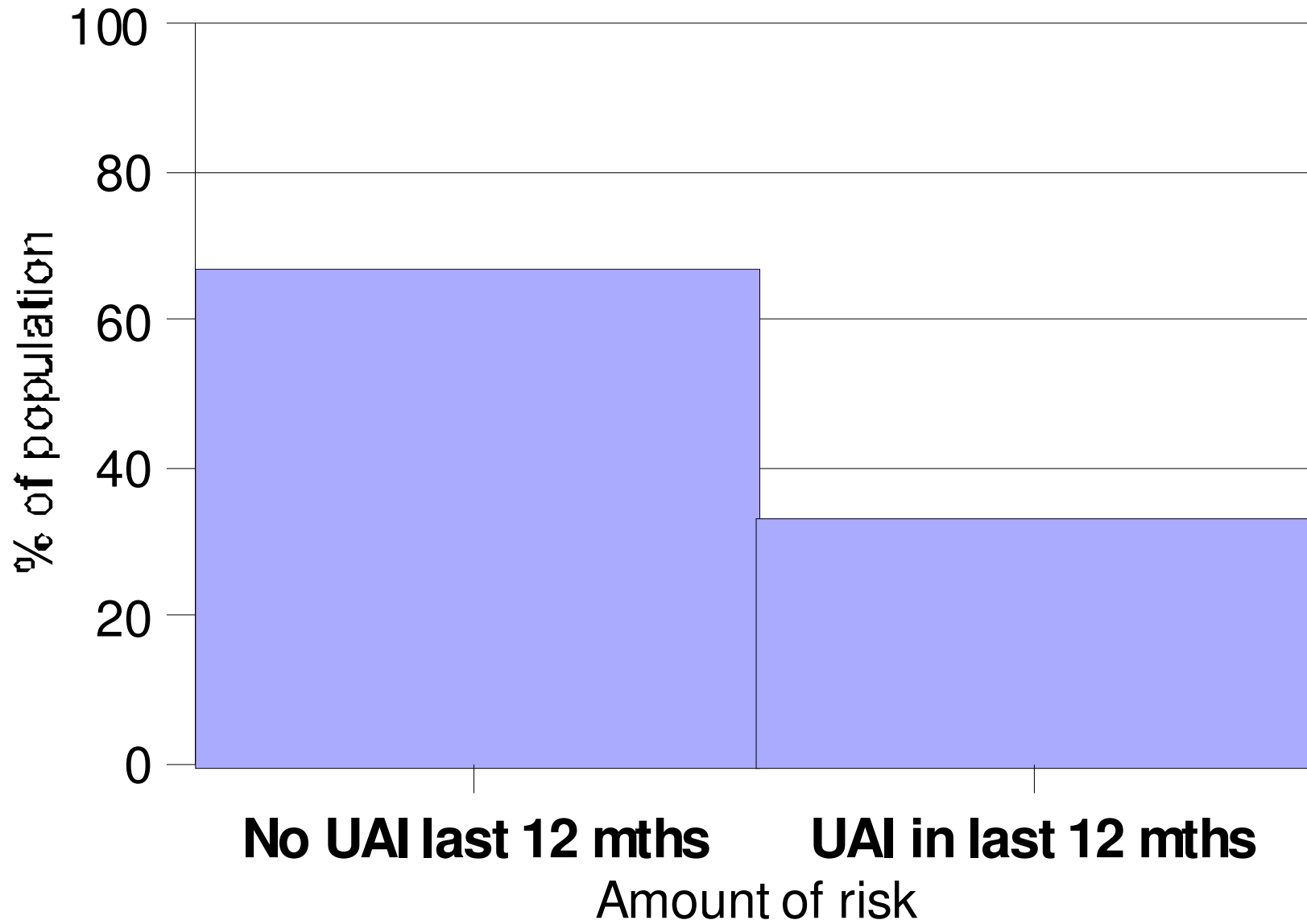




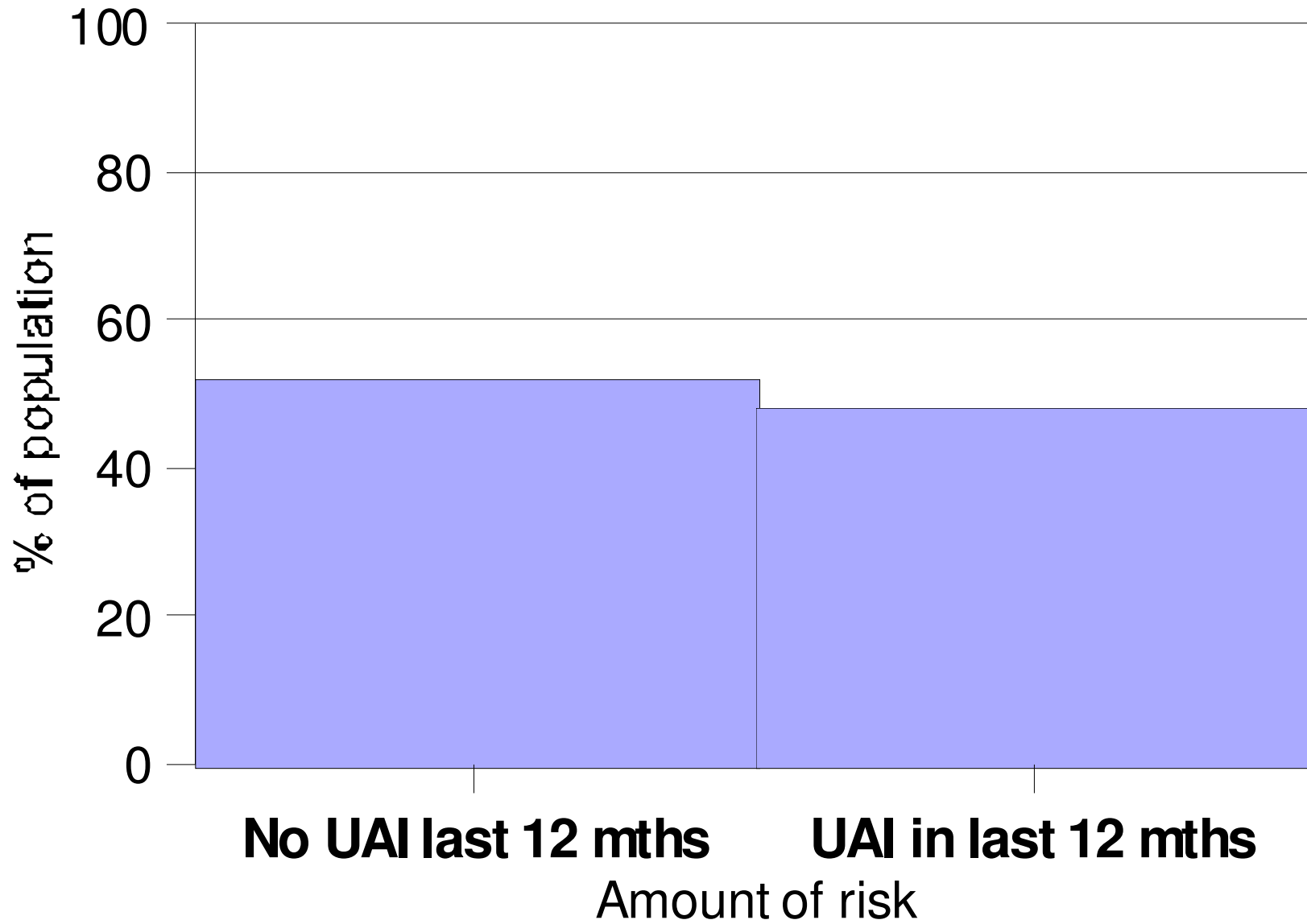
Population risk profile



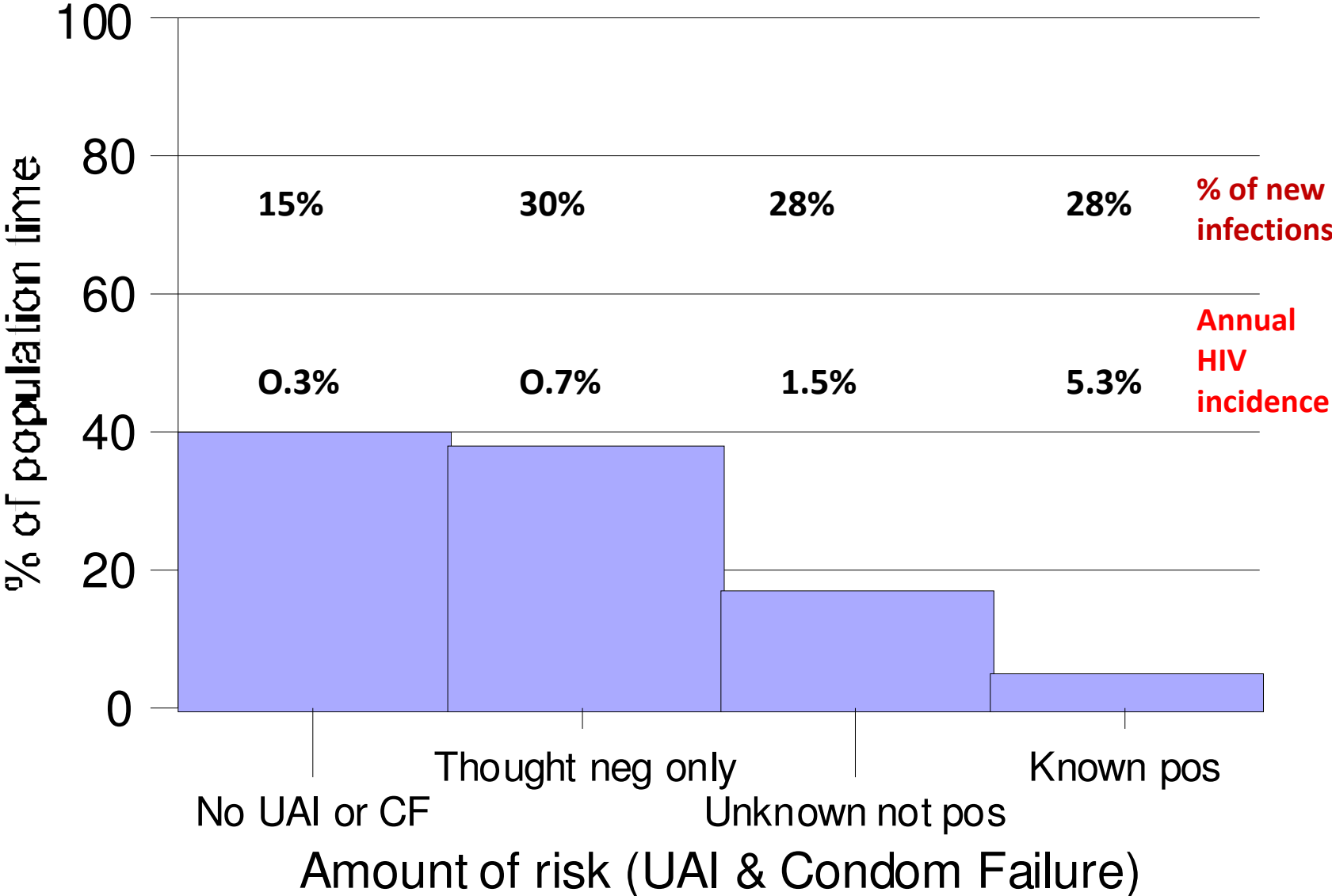
Population risk profile (UK GMSS 1998)



Population risk profile (UK GMSS 2008)

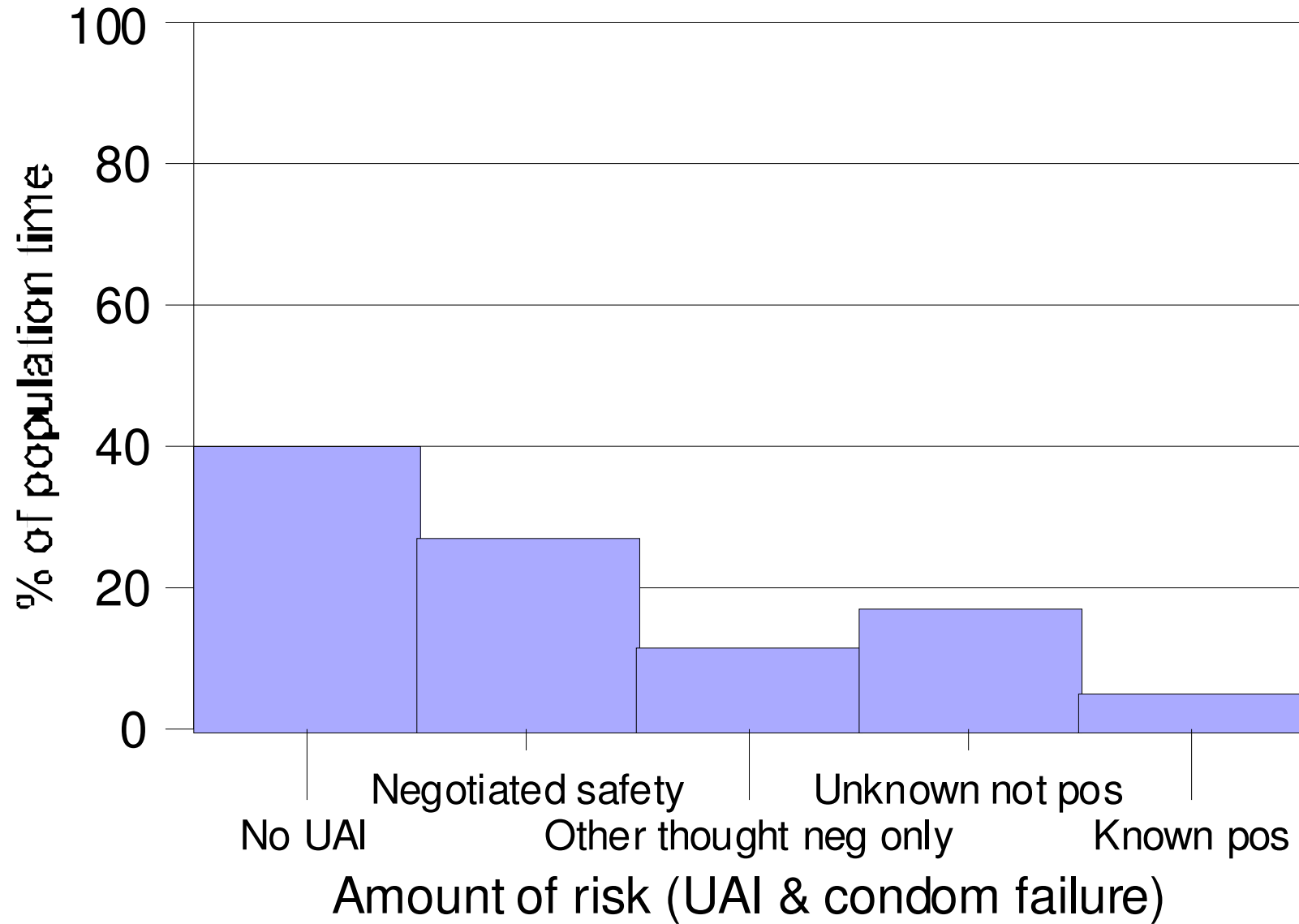


Population risk profile (Sydney HIM Study 2001-4)



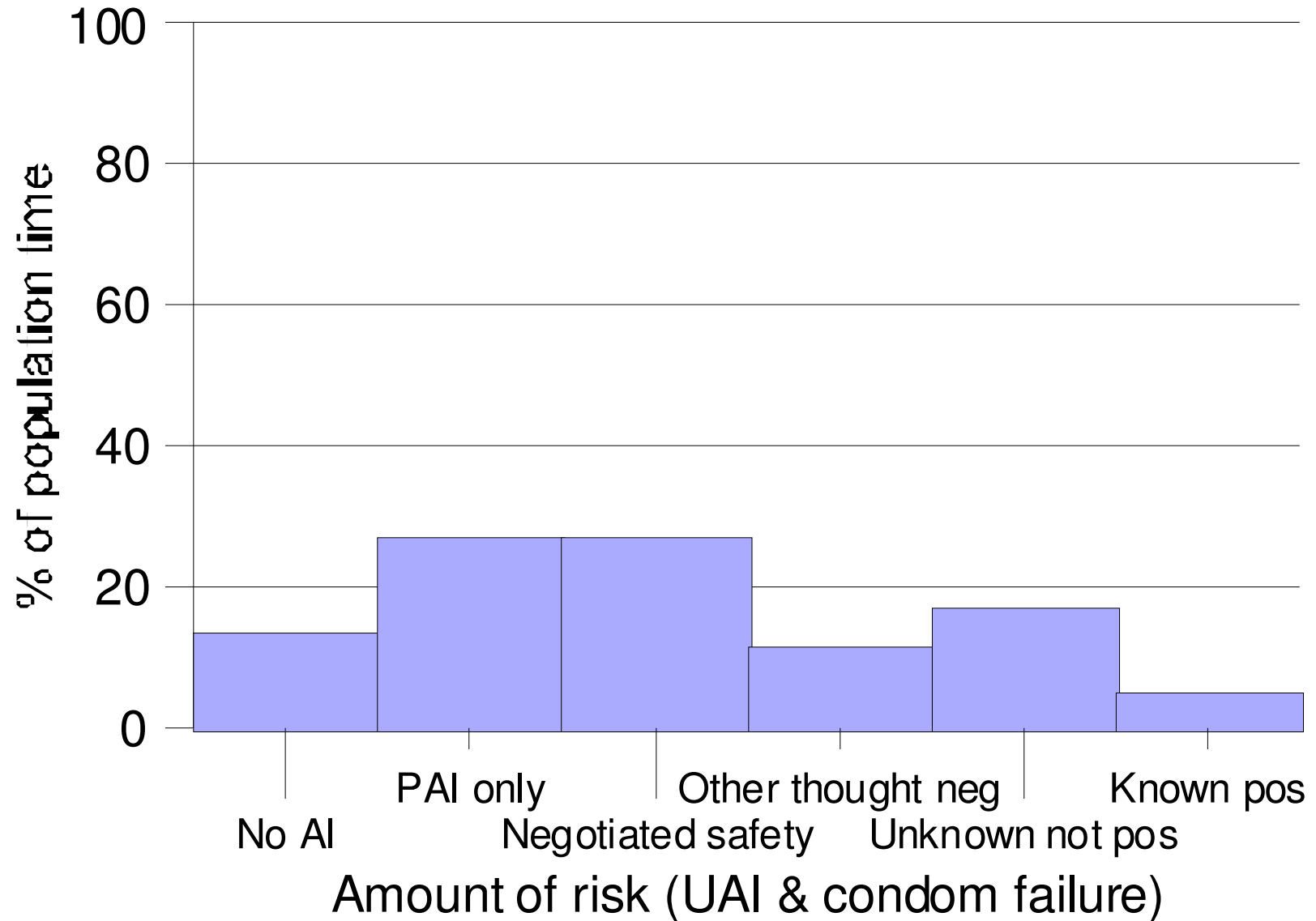

Population risk profile (Sydney HIM Study 2001-4)

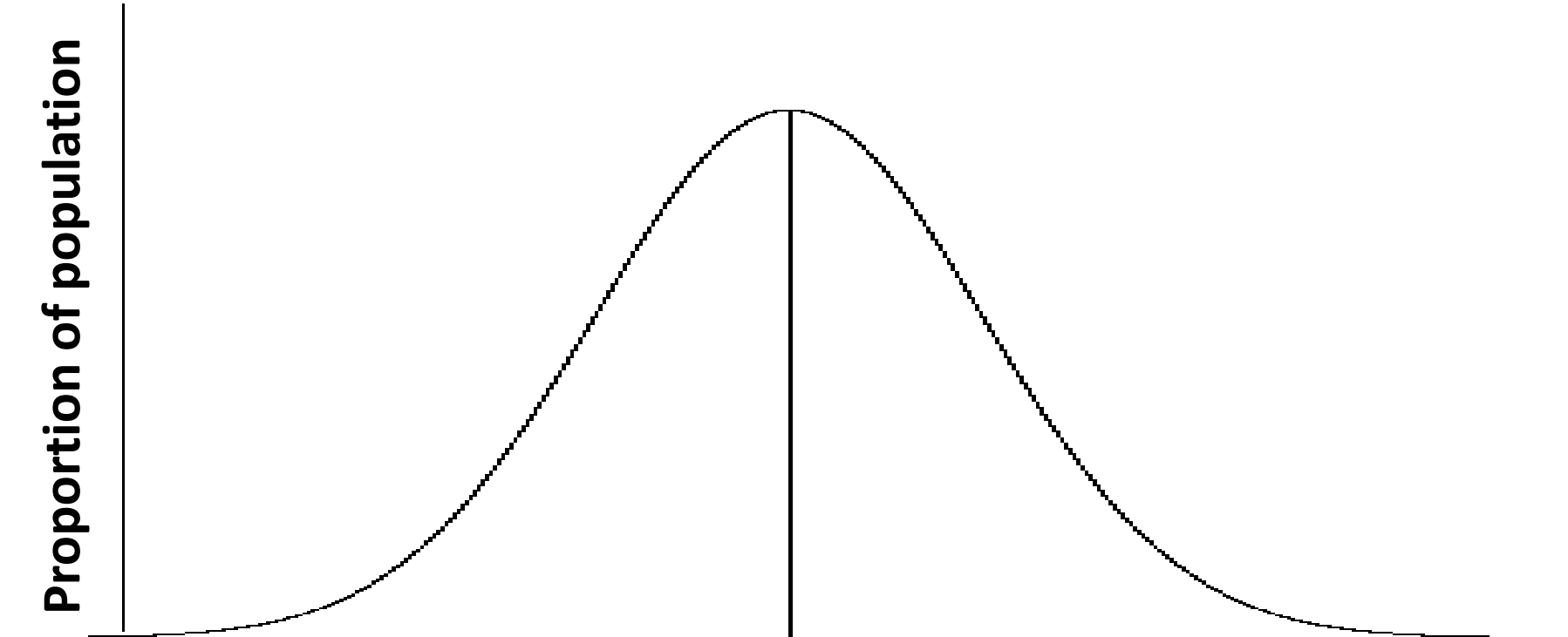

- Bareback
- Ejaculating into the body
- Using poppers
- Not seeking PEP

The best sex?

- Confident of not having an STI
- No sex, deferred sex or pre-dated sex
- Disclosed and discussed sex
- Monogamous relationships
- Without intercourse
- With condoms
- Ejaculating outside the body
- Not using poppers
- Seeking PEP afterwards

The best sex with least harm?

Confident **or** Unconfident of passing on an STI?
Declined or deferred **or** Sex now with new partner?
Disclosed and discussed **or** Silent?
Monogamous **or** Open relationships?
Non-penetrative **or** Anal intercourse?
Condom **or** Bareback?
Ejaculation in the body **or** Outside the body?
No poppers **or** Poppers?
PEP **or** No PEP?
